NOTICE OF RACE

1. Rules

- 1.1. The 2016 Flying Scot New England District Championship Regatta will be governed by the 2013-2016 Racing Rules of Sailing.
- 1.2. The rules and specifications of the Flying Scot Sailing Association will apply.
- 1.3. Certain rules may be changed and these changes will appear in the Massabesic Yacht Club Sailing Instructions 2016.
- 1.4. By participating in this regatta, a competitor grants to the organization authority and its sponsors the right in perpetuity to make, use and show, from time to time at their discretion, any photographs, motion pictures, and live, taped or filmed television and other reproductions of him or her during the period of the competition without compensation.

2. Eligibility & Entry

- 2.1. The regatta is open to qualified boats of the Flying Scot Class.
- 2.2. Flying Scot Class Association membership is required. To join the FSSA, go to: http://www.fssa.com/join.

3. Registration

- 3.1 Registration for this district championship event shall be made by mail using the attached registration form (postmarked by August 6th).
- 3.2 Participants may also register in person at the Massabesic Yacht Club from 1700-1900 on Friday, August 19th, or from 0800-1000 on Saturday, August 20th.

4. Fees

- 4.1 The early entry fee for registrations postmarked by Saturday, August 6th is \$70. The fee for onsite registration is \$80.
- 4.2 The registration fee includes all racing activity, and food/beverage refreshments to include a reception on Friday evening (8/19), as well as a continental breakfast, lunch makings, and a dinner on Saturday (8/20) for each boat skipper and one crew member.
- 4.3 There will be a fee of \$20 for each additional crew member, which includes all meals and refreshments.

5. Boats/Measurement

- 5.1. Flying Scot sailboats will be used for this district championship regatta.
- 5.2. Each competitor is responsible to assure that her/his boat is in compliance with the Flying Scot class rules and specifications.
- 5.3. Boats entered into this district championship regatta may be inspected for compliance with class rules.

6. Lake Massabesic Watershed Regulations

- 6.1 Lake Massabesic is a pristine water body in central New Hampshire which serves as the drinking water supply for the City of Manchester. As such, the lake and watershed are strictly regulated by the Manchester Water Works Department.
- 6.2 Please observe the guidelines and regulations for recreation on and around Lake Massabesic. Foremost among them include: no swimming or bathing in Lake Massabesic, dogs must be leashed at all times, and no littering or camping in or around Lake Massabesic.
- 6.3 The Massabesic Yacht Club leases land from the Manchester Water Works Department in order to establish and maintain a sailing club. Although there is running water for washing, there are no formal restroom facilities at the MYC (portable toilets are used, with an 'Executive' unit designated for women).

7. Schedule of Events

7.1. Friday, August 19

1300-1900 Massabesic Yacht Club open for arrivals, with logistical, rigging, and launching support offered (the MYC uses a launching ramp).

1700-1900 Registration and Welcome Reception

7.2. Saturday, August 20th -- Up to six races are planned. Times indicated are approximate.

1015	Harbor gun, followed by Race 1 and subsequent races

1700	Dinner, awards, and farewells
1900	Regatta concludes

- 8. Sailing Instructions The sailing instructions can be found on the MYC website racing page (http://www.mycsailing.com/mycracing.htm), and will be available at registration.
- 9. Scoring A maximum of six (6) races are scheduled, of which one (1) shall be completed to constitute a series. No race scores will be excluded (no throw-outs).

- 10. Prizes Awards will be given to competitors placing first through fifth.
- 11. Disclaimer of Liability Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See Rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

- From I-93 and points West and North and South of Manchester, take Exit 7, Route 101 East (Seacoast).
- From points East of Manchester, go towards Manchester on Route 101.
- Take Exit 1 and go south onto Route 28 By-pass. Travel 1/8 mile to traffic circle.
- Proceed half way through the circle, continuing on the Route 28 By-pass. (Londonderry Turnpike.) You'll see Lake Massabesic on your left, and a municipal parking area.
- Travel 1/3 mile past the lake parking area.
- Not far after the yellow traffic sign, turn left into the MYC parking lot. You will see a white post at entrance.
