NOTICE OF RACE

1. Rules

- 1.1. The Massabesic Yacht Club Annual One Design Regatta will be governed by the *2013-2016 Racing Rules of Sailing*.
- 1.2. The rules and specifications of the International Lightning Class Association, Windmill Class Association, and the Flying Scot Sailing Association will apply.
- 1.3. Certain rules may be changed and these changes will appear in the Massabesic Yacht Club Sailing Instructions 2016 (posted on the MYC website racing page).
- 1.4. By participating in this regatta, a competitor grants to the organization authority and its sponsors the right in perpetuity to make, use and show, from time to time at their discretion, any photographs, motion pictures, and live, taped or filmed television and other reproductions of him or her during the period of the competition without compensation.

2. Eligibility & Entry

- 2.1. The regatta is open to qualified boats of the Lightning, Windmill, and Flying Scot Class.
- 2.2. United States Sailing Association and Class Association membership is strongly encouraged, but not required to participate in this club regatta.

3. Registration

- 3.1 Registration for the Massabesic Yacht Club Annual Regatta – 2016 shall be made by mail using the attached registration form (postmarked by Sept. 3rd).
- 3.2 Participants may also register in person at the Massabesic Yacht Club from 1700-1900 on Friday, Sept. 16th, or from 0800-1000 on Saturday, Sept. 17th.

4. Fees

- 4.1 The early entry fee for registrations postmarked by Saturday, September 3rd is \$80. The fee for onsite registration is \$90.
- 4.2 The registration fee includes all racing activity, and food/beverage refreshments to include a reception on Friday evening (9/16), as well as a continental breakfast, lunch makings, and a dinner on Saturday (9/17) for each boat skipper and one crew member. A continental breakfast and après-race refreshments will also be served on Sunday (9/18).
- 4.3 There will be a fee of \$20 for each additional crew member, which includes all meals and refreshments.

5. Boats/Measurement

- 5.1. Lightning, Windmill, and Flying Scot sailboats will be used for this regatta.
- 5.2. Each competitor is responsible to assure that her/his boat is in compliance with class rules and specifications.
- 5.3. Boats entered into this regatta may be inspected for compliance with class rules.

6. Lake Massabesic Watershed Regulations

- 6.1 Lake Massabesic is a pristine water body in central New Hampshire which serves as the drinking water supply for the City of Manchester. As such, the lake and watershed are strictly regulated by the Manchester Water Works Department.
- 6.2 Please observe the guidelines and regulations for recreation on and around Lake Massabesic. Foremost among them include: no swimming or bathing in Lake Massabesic, dogs must be leashed at all times, and no littering or camping in or around Lake Massabesic.
- 6.3 The Massabesic Yacht Club leases land from the Manchester Water Works Department in order to establish and maintain a sailing club. Although there is running water for washing, there are no formal restroom facilities at the MYC (portable toilets are used, with an 'Executive' unit designated for women).

7. Schedule of Events

7.1. Friday, September 16th

- 1300-1900 Massabesic Yacht Club open for arrivals, with logistical, rigging, and launching support offered (the MYC uses a launching ramp).
- 1700-1900 Registration and Welcome Reception

7.2. Saturday, September 17th -- Up to six races are planned. Times indicated are approximate.

- 0800 Welcome, registration, breakfast, and launching (logistical, rigging, and launching support offered --the MYC uses a launching ramp).
- 1000 Skippers meeting
- 1015 Harbor gun, followed by Race 1 and subsequent races
- 1230 Intermission for lunch and restroom facilities access
- 1315 Harbor gun, followed by Race 4 and subsequent races
- 1600 No races will start after this time.
- 1630 Post-race reception begins

1800 Dinner service begins
2000 MYC closes for regatta participants

7.3. Sunday, September 18th -- Up to four races are planned. Times indicated are approximate.

0800 Breakfast, and launching (logistical, rigging, and launching support offered --the MYC uses a launching ramp).
1000 Skippers meeting
1015 Harbor gun, followed by Race 6 and subsequent races
1300 No races will start after this time, packing and hauling begin
1400 Post-race reception begins, awards, and farewells
1500 Regatta concludes

8. Sailing Instructions – The sailing instructions can be found on the MYC website racing page (<http://www.mycsailing.com/mycracing.htm>), and will be available at registration.

9. Scoring – A maximum of eight (8) races are scheduled, of which three (3) shall be completed to constitute a series. One race score will be excluded (1 throw-out), if more than seven races are held.

10. Prizes – Awards will be given to competitors placing first through third (up to 10 boats per class), or first through fifth (more than 10 boats per class) – as of the early registration deadline. Also, early registration gifts will be given to each skipper and one crew member registered on or by the early registration deadline (gifts for additional crew members can be purchased for \$5 each).

11. Disclaimer of Liability – Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See Rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

Directions:

- From I-93 and points West and North and South of Manchester, take Exit 7, Route 101 East (Seacoast).
- From points East of Manchester, go towards Manchester on Route 101.
- Take Exit 1 and go south onto Route 28 By-pass. Travel 1/8 mile to traffic circle.
- Proceed half way through the circle, continuing on the Route 28 By-pass. (Londonderry Turnpike.) You'll see Lake Massabesic on your left, and a municipal parking area.
- Travel 1/3 mile past the lake parking area.
- Not far after the yellow traffic sign, turn left into the MYC parking lot. You will see a white post at entrance.
